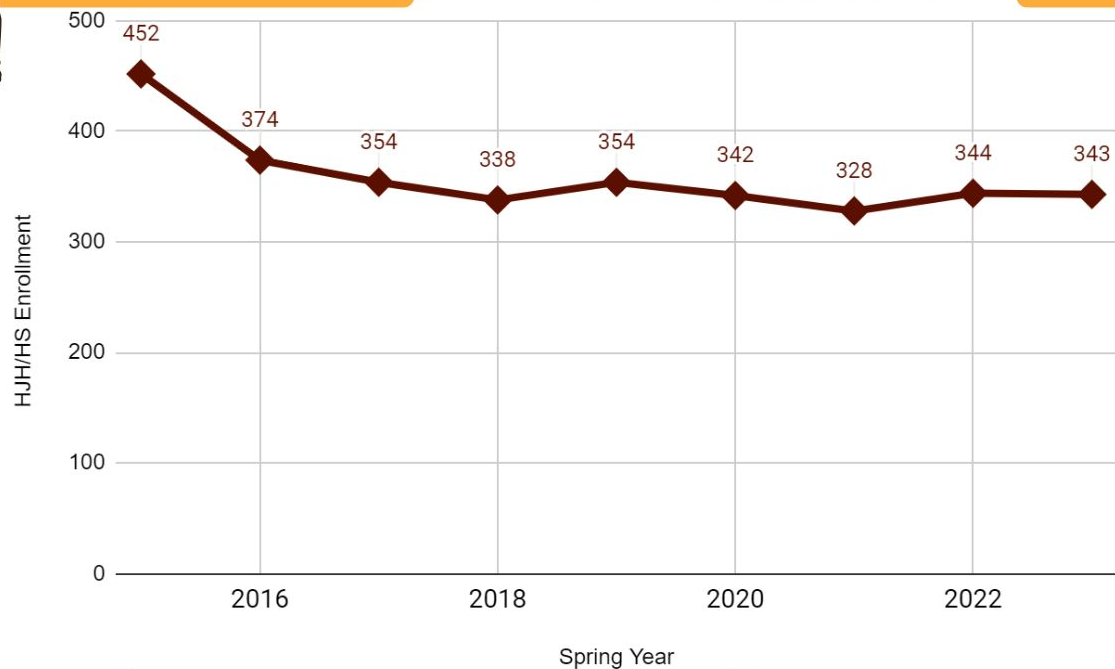

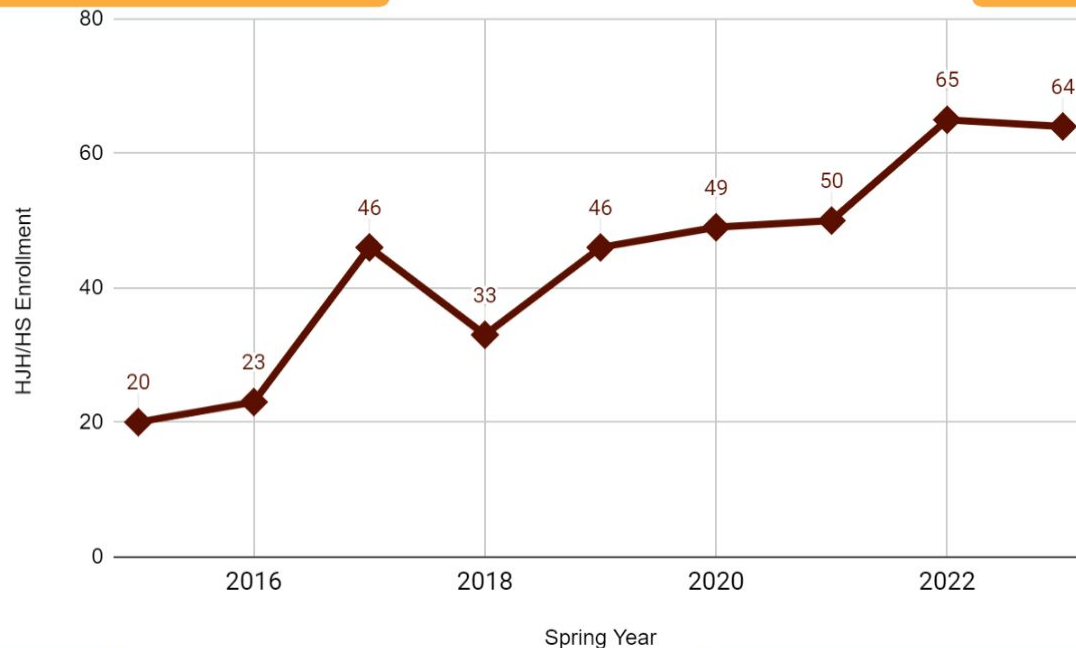
Student Enrollment

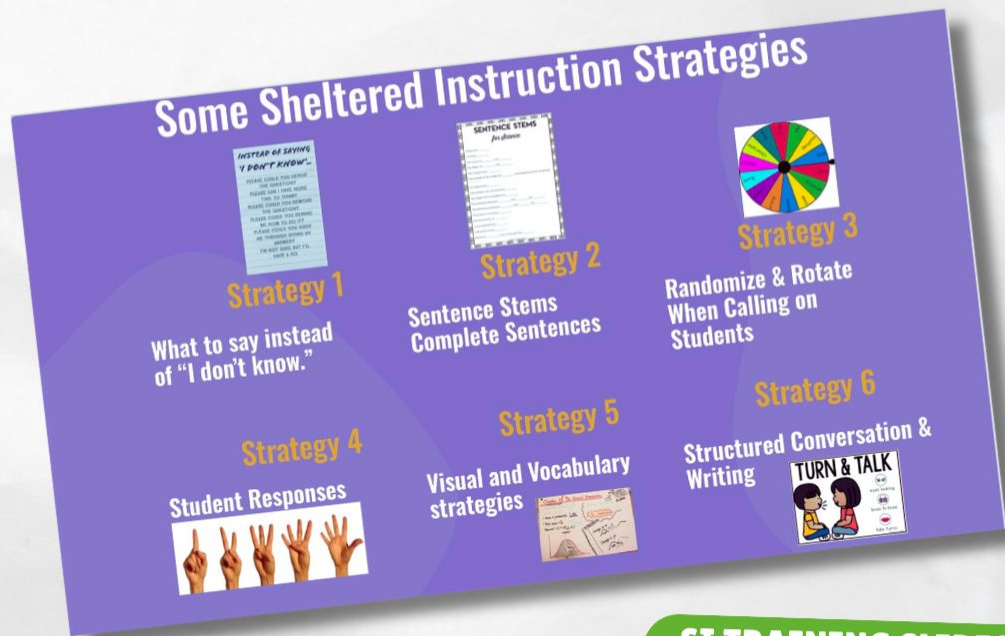
Goal Setting

- Provided resources for classrooms as non-negotiables



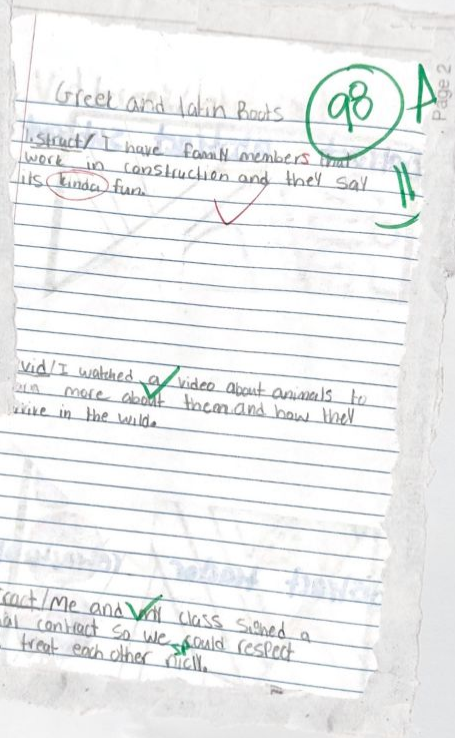
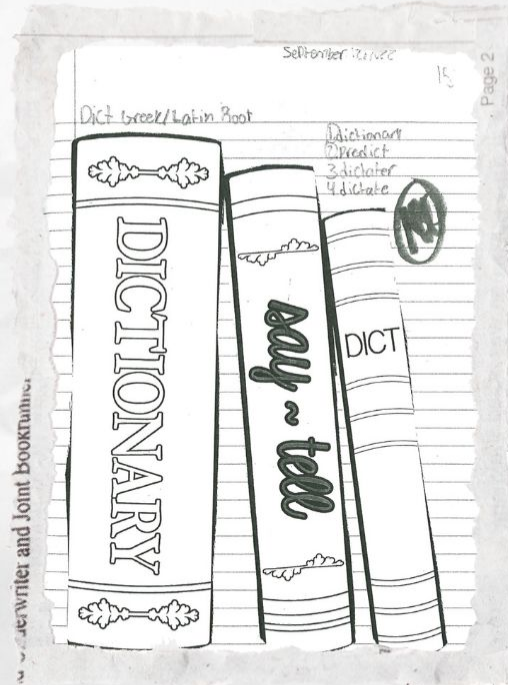
